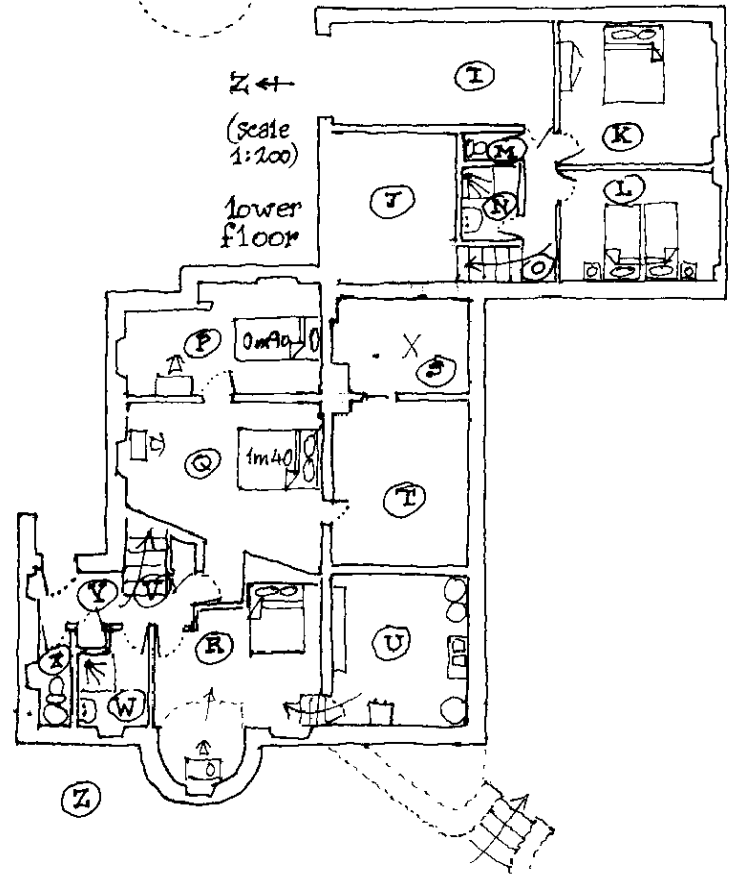
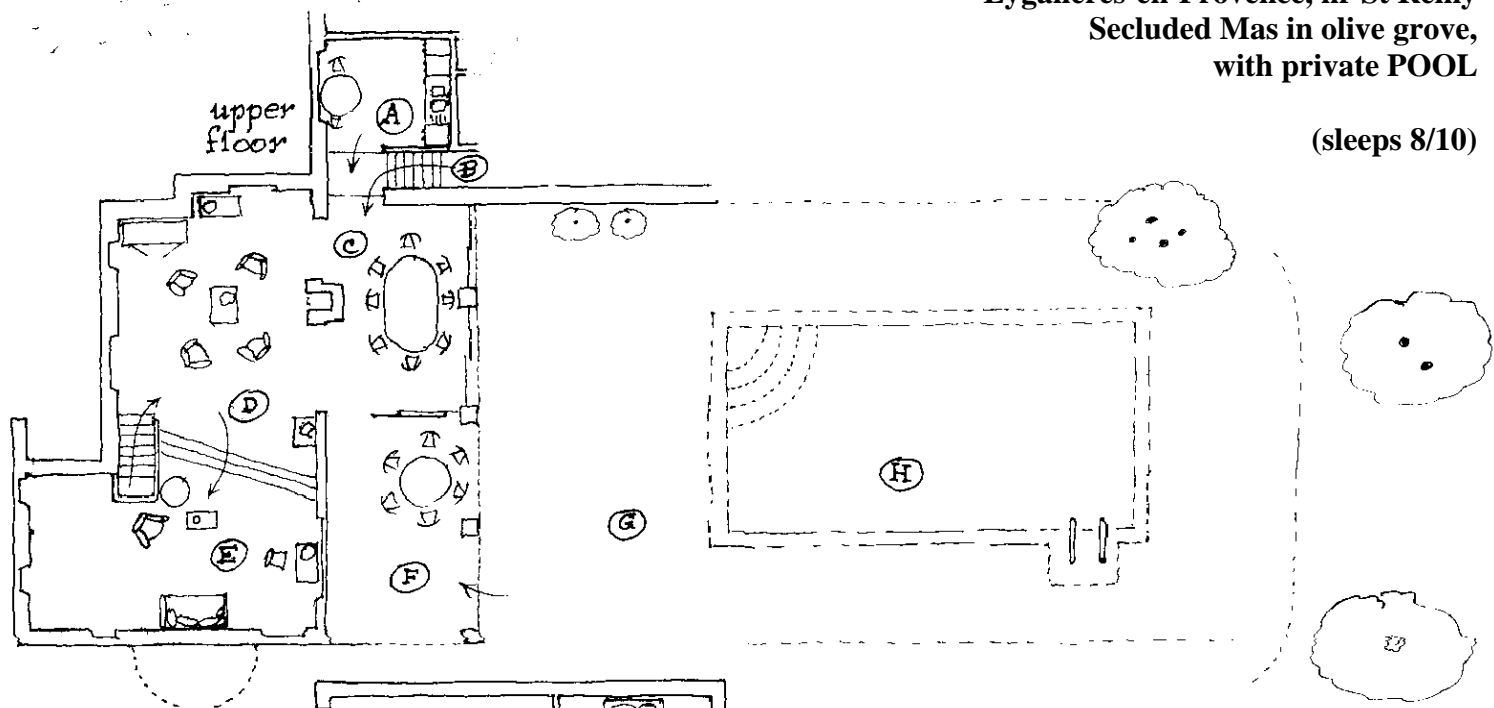


Eygalieres-en-Provence, nr St Rémy
Secluded Mas in olive grove,
with private POOL

(sleeps 8/10)



Eygalieres-en-Provence is considered by many to be the prettiest village in Provence. It is a village of great antiquity, crowned by a hilltop mediaeval hamlet, of haunting beauty, and goes back to Roman times, as witnessed by the Chapelle Sainte Sixte and by the fine aqueduct, of which parts remain, by which the Romans supplied Arles with water from springs rediscovered just east of the village. Eygalieres is like a jewel set in the clasp of the Alpilles hills, to which the land rises on all sides, vineyard turning to 'maquis', the pines and evergreen oaks rising from a carpet of herbs, hyssop, alyssum, lavendula stoeacas, cistus, iris, aphyllanthes, thyme, rosemary.

In just such surroundings, and some olive trees, stands the Mas, in peace and seclusion, barely a kilometre from the village, which has all shops (including 2 excellent bakeries), 2 cafés, four good restaurants. The house is spacious, substantially built in the local stone, and includes 5 bedrooms in two groups, *K L* reached by stairs *O, P Q R* by stairs *V*. The house has 2 bathrooms (showers, basins *N W*, and 2 WCs *M X*), washing machine *U*, dishwasher in neat well-fitted kitchen *A* opening to dining area, a split-level living room *D E* and covered terrace *F* beside patio *G* and 11m x 5m pool *H*. An excellent property in a lovely setting.
