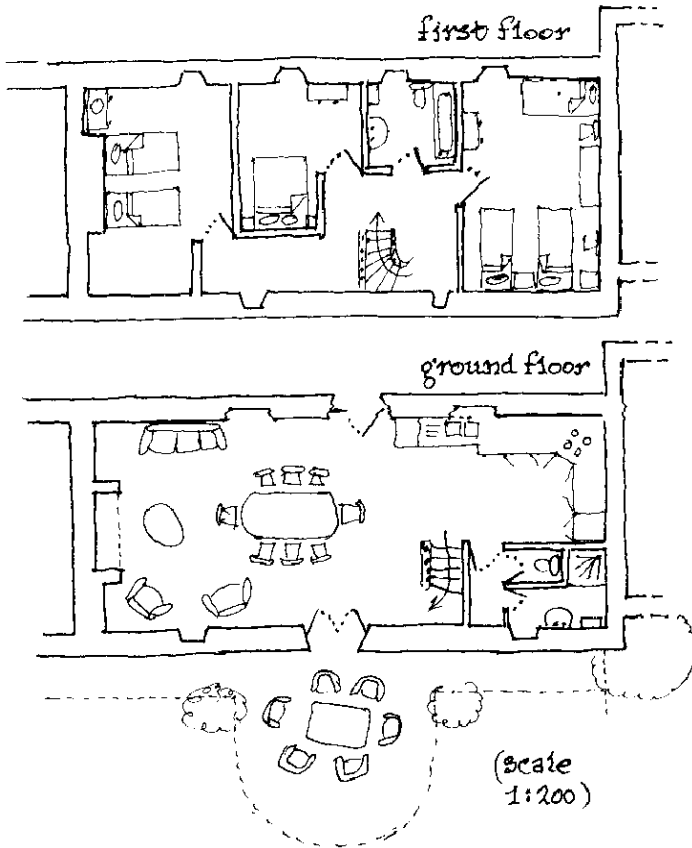




**West Brittany
Audierne, Finistère, 2½km beaches**

**Farm Wing of 14th Century Manoir
with spacious garden**

(sleeps 7+)



This substantial and elegant property lies in peaceful farmland near the hamlet of Esquibien, about 2km from the very pretty fishing harbour of Audierne (excellent restaurants, bakers, all shopping facilities) and about 12km from La Pointe-du-Raz, the westernmost tip of France. The property is within easy reach of the ferry terminal of Roscoff (say 1½ hours) though further from Caen (6h+).

Comfortably independent of the Manoir (sleeping 14) and a separate Cottage (sleeps 5), each with their own garden/patio, the Farm Wing is entered from a common cobbled courtyard, nicely planted with rosebushes and other attractive hedges etc, and opens westwards to a paved patio (table and chairs etc) surrounded by a large beautifully tended lawn, allegedly once the theatre of mediaeval jousting tournaments. It slopes fairly markedly uphill from north to south, but doubtless this just toughened the challenges with which the knights had to contend.

Accommodation includes 3 bedrooms (1double and 5 single beds), 2 bathrooms (1 bath, 1 shower, 2 WCs) and a very spacious living room with quite beautifully fitted kitchen (4-ring hob, separate eye-level oven, washing machine, dishwasher, copious cupboards and worktop), dining table and 8 chairs, sofa and 2 armchairs, open fire. The property is decorated to a high standard, impeccably clean, and furnished without sophisticated pretension but with practicality and agreeable taste.

Highly recommended.
